

## CS Unsold Book Sale 2024: Notes and Rules

1. The books are listed and described in good faith; but they are basically sold "as is". Please note that books may have book plates and/or owner's signatures, and library stamps; these haven't always been mentioned in the catalogue.
2. If anyone needs further information about any item, please contact Bas Payne (address and e-address below).
3. Orders should be emailed or posted to the addresses below ([order form](#)).
4. Orders from CS members will be dealt with in the order in which they are received.
5. The sale is open to non-members, however their orders will be held until 15 days after the posting of a price list in order to give priority to CS members.
6. After one month, prices of books/items remaining unsold will be dropped by 25-33% and the new price list will be posted on the CS website
7. Books may be collected from my home (in Devon: address below); I will if asked do my best to bring books to meetings (but I don't go to all meetings) so that buyers can collect them there; if they are posted/sent by carrier, I will do my best to pack them securely.
8. Payment (including packing (£1 per parcel) and postage/delivery costs where applicable) must be received before books can be sent to or collected by buyers.
9. Payment can be made in cash, by cheque, or by direct bank transfer; I can't take card payments; I can take Paypal payments, but Paypal charges will be added.
10. If books have not been paid for within 30 days, the order will be cancelled.
11. I will try to take good care of the books, but once payment has been received they become the property of the bidder and CS cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage thereafter.
