

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR 2016

In 2016 we had 249 members of all types (detailed below) and 71 subscribers to the journal. Of these, 18 were new members (including 3 overseas members and two family memberships). There was 1 new institutional subscriber.

Prospects for 2017:

With regard to renewal of our members from 2016, we were notified during 2016 that one life member and two ordinary members had died, and one family member and one institutional subscriber wished to resign before 2017. In early 2017 two members have cancelled their payments ahead of renewing for 2017.

As of 10 February 2017, 162 members of all types have already renewed their memberships (not including the 20 honorary and life members), as have 49 institutional subscribers; we have 7 new members in 2017 and one new institutional subscriber.
